Communiqué

The President of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela, Nicolás Maduro Moros, on behalf of the Venezuelan people and the Bolivarian Government, sends a message of admiration, love and commitment to the Cuban people and Government on the 62nd anniversary of the triumph of the Cuban Revolution.
